



EMT 40 HOUR REFRESHER COURSE

WHAT:

This 40-Hour EMT Refresher course includes course curriculum, psychomotor skills evaluation, and AHA HCP CPR card. Participants who successfully complete the program will receive the 40 Hour EMT Refresher Course Certificate of Completion and Skills Evaluation Verification Form needed to be eligible to take the NREMT. Curriculum is online. Psychomotor skills meet in person.

This course will meet:

- the 20 hours of the National, 10 hours of the State/Local and 10 hours of the Individual education requirements for National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) recertification via the National Continued Competency Program (NCCP) model.
- the education requirements for state-approved refresher courses which are required for lapsed NREMT certifications or for those who failed the NREMT exam three times.
- the education requirements for Washington State continuing medical education (CME) recertification requirements WAC 246-976-162 for EMTs who do not meet ongoing training and evaluation program (OTEP) requirements listed in WAC 246-976-163.

Washington EMT providers recertifying per CME method will still need to pass the Washington cognitive assessment examination through NREMT/Pearson Vue. Participants will need a computer to access the online curriculum portion of the program.

Skills for the NREMT are evaluated by a Washington State approved EMS Evaluator.
