

<u>COURSE DETAILS:</u> This course is designed to obtain EMT certification by challenging the initial EMT educational training requirements based on possession of a current health care provider credential. Upon successful completion of this course, participants will be eligible to apply to test for NREMT.

This course includes IV and SGA training. Students' MPD must approve IV endorsement.

THIS IS AN ACCELERATED, HYBRID COURSE AND WILL REQUIRE STRONG MOTIVATION AND SELF-DISCIPLINE TO MANEUVER WITH A HEAVY READING SCHEDULE AND MEMORIZATION OF SKILL SHEETS. STUDENTS MUST BE PREPARED TO COMMIT TO COMPLETE ALL READING, HOMEWORK AND QUIZ ASSIGNMENTS ON TIME AND ATTEND THE SCHEDULED SKILLS/FIELD LAB SESSION(S).
